



Certificate in Diabetes Self-management (Adults) PG25749 QQI Accredited Level 8 Special Purpose Award (10 ECTS Credits)

Programme Aim

The aim of this programme is to enhance registered nurses knowledge, skills and understanding of diabetes to apply an integrated person-centred holistic approach to support adults self-manage and live well with their condition.

Programme Learning Outcomes

Upon successful completion of the programme, the learner will be able to:

- Critically analyse and evaluate current national reforms in healthcare relevant to the promotion of selfmanagement supports for adults with diabetes;
- Demonstrate detailed knowledge and understanding of the classification, screening and diagnosis of diabetes;
- Apply a holistic person centred approach to support adults' self-manage their diabetes;
- Critically appraise the health-promoting role of the nurse in the prevention and management of complications of diabetes;
- Exercise appropriate judgement in medication therapy management to optimise glycaemic control and prevent and manage complications of diabetes.

Entry Requirements: Programme applicants must:

- Be registered nurses actively registered with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland;
- Be working in a HSE and/or HSE funded healthcare environment (Section 38);
- Be caring for adults who are at risk of and/or living with diabetes (excluding diabetes in pregnancy) in any of the following settings:
 - \circ General;
 - o Mental Health;
 - $\circ \quad \ \ \text{Care of the Older Person;} \\$
 - $\circ \quad \mbox{Intellectual Disability;} \\$
 - Community.
- Have completed the following eLearning programmes on www.hseland.ie:
 - Making Every Contact Count (MECC) (8 x 30 minute eLearning modules);
 - Diabetic Foot Screening.
- Be available to attend RCNME Tullamore on all identified dates
