NCLC Clinical Leadership Development Programme for Staff Nurses and Staff Midwives (14 NMBI CEUs)

Programme

This two day **virtual** foundation programme will support staff nurses and staff midwives to engage in clinical leadership development using an interactive facilitated mode of delivery. **Participants must attend both day 1 and day 2 in order to complete the programme**

Aim

This is the first step on the NCLC leadership development journey for staff nurses and staff midwives. It will guide participants to enhance their clinical leadership confidence by recognizing their influence as clinical leaders through the development of clinical leadership competencies.

Learning outcomes:

Participants will have the opportunity to:

- ✓ Understand the importance of self-awareness in clinical leadership
- ✓ Explore core values that may impact on clinical leadership
- ✓ Demonstrate personal effectiveness through communication
- ✓ Build confidence by cultivating empowerment and advocacy
- ✓ Understand the importance of decision making to promote quality improvement
- ✓ Explore the impact of teamwork on patient/client care
- ✓ Recognise the importance of self-care as a clinical leader

What can participants expect on the programme?

This programme offers a combination of individual reflective learning (by completing the pre-learning workbook) and attending the two day facilitated virtual learning platform. **Completing the pre-learning workbook is an essential pre-requisite to completing the two day virtual facilitated sessions.**
