3.0 Policy Statement

The Consortium of Centres of Nursing and Midwifery Education (CCNME) promote a culture of learning which advocates the values of care, compassion, commitment, trust and learning for both staff and learners. Staff and Learners are obliged to uphold these values and adhere to Learner Code of Conduct and Academic Integrity policy and procedure. This policy and related procedure outlines the steps to be taken and penalties that may be imposed in the event of a breach of these policies and procedures.

4.1 Academic Council

- 4.1.1 Provide oversight and monitoring of all academic matters as it relates to QQI validated programmes of education;
- 4.1.2 Convene the Disciplinary Committee following notification from the Chairperson of the Programme Board;
- 4.1.3 Receive reports from the Chairperson of the Disciplinary Committee following the Disciplinary hearing.

4.2 Disciplinary Committee

- 4.2.1 Convene the members of the Disciplinary Committee to include representation from the Academic Integrity Committee, if relevant;
- 4.2.2 Provide the learner with notification of meeting date (five working days' notice);
- 4.2.3 Treat learners fairly and consistently within the CCNMEs Learner Code of Conduct and Disciplinary procedure;
- 4.2.4 Review, hear, consider and adjudicate allegations and suspected cases of misconduct, together with awarding penalties;
- 4.2.5 Provide the learner with written confirmation of the panel decision and access to Appeals policy and procedure, if requested;
- 4.2.6 Maintain a record of the process and outcome of the hearing using the appropriate form;
- 4.2.7 Maintain records of suspected, alleged or proven cases of misconduct to inform effective prevention approaches;
- 4.2.8 Submit an annual report to Academic Council on activities of the Committee.

4.3 Academic Integrity Committee

- 4.3.1 Determine if academic integrity breach warrants referral to Disciplinary Committee;
- 4.3.2 Review, hear, consider, and adjudicate allegations and suspected cases of academic integrity/misconduct, together with awarding penalties, in collaboration with the Disciplinary Committee.

4.4 Programme Boards

- 4.4.1 Inform the Academic Council of suspected/alleged misconduct and request referral of the alleged case to the Disciplinary Committee;
- 4.4.2 Collects data on breaches of conduct by learners and on an annual basis, submits to Academic Council to inform ongoing quality improvement.

4.5 CCNME Programme Teams

- 4.5.1 Directs learners to the supports and resources available within the CCNME, e.g. academic supports, learner mental health and well-being resources;
- 4.5.2 Have a responsibility to prevent, detect and manage misconduct;
- 4.5.3 Reports any breaches of learner conduct and adheres to the procedures on managing misconduct.

4.6 Learner

- 4.6.1 Access and adhere to the relevant CCNME policies and procedures;
- 4.6.2 Act responsibly, be honest, and courteous towards others;
- 4.6.3 Take personal responsibility for actions and behaviour;
- 4.6.4 Communicates with Programme Co-ordinator to seek advice and support at regular intervals;
