4.1 Academic Council

4.1.1 The Academic Council and its committees oversee monitoring of learner attendance as a vital component of learner retention, progression, achievement and delegate this authority to relevant Committees.

4.2 Programme Committees

- 4.2.1 Oversight of the attendance procedure ensuring that all information relating to learner attendance is up to date and accurate;
- 4.2.2 Review attendance requirements, and programme information with Quality Enhancement prior to advertising by CCNME Programme Teams (appendix 5);

- 4.2.3 Determine the possible outcomes for the learner as part of the Procedure on Managing Learner Attendance and Absenteeism;
- 4.2.4 Monitors the effectiveness and efficiency of this policy and procedures;
- 4.2.5 Incorporates staff and learner feedback on this learner attendance and absenteeism policy.

4.3 CCNME Programme Teams

- 4.3.1 Provide information on programmes as agreed with Programme Committee and Quality Enhancement Committee, which is clear, accurate, objective, upto date and readily accessible on CCNME online platform in line with HSE requirements on publishing;
- 4.3.2 Ensures the learner is fully aware of their obligations in relation to:
 - 4.3.2.1 Attendance and provides the learner with clear information:
 - As applicants, via programme advertisement;
 - On offer of a place;
 - As learners, once registered on the programme;
 - In the learner programme handbook;
 - On monitoring of attendance records using Learner Attendance Registers/Record.
 - 4.3.2.2 Absenteeism, including the implications and consequences of absences at QQI validated programmes (levels 5-8), (Refer to Procedure on Managing Learner Attendance and Absenteeism).
