

The Implementation of Outpatient Midwifery Induction of Labour; to provide choice and reduce time waiting

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Aims and Objectives (S.M.A.R.T)



To reduce time waiting for women attending for induction. While offering choice to these women, by returning home post the midwife administering a Dinoprostone pessary.


- Local guideline to be in place, by September 22nd 2017.
- 50% of induction staff will have completed Induction education sessions by October 10th 2017.
- 75% reduction in median waiting time, by February 28th 2018.
- 30% of midwifery Inductions will return home for maximum 24hrs.








Pareto Chart (overall time waiting)








Methods

Stability, well-being and engagement have been enhanced through the use of the HSE Change Model ¹.

Stakeholder involvement; Initiation, Planning, Implementation & Mainstreaming.


Measurable through time waiting analysis (pre and post change auditing) and the percentage of women returning home.

Data was collected over five months. 76 charts were compared.






Reduced time waiting for midwife led inductions

Choices for women being induced in the Rotunda Hospital



High risk

- Obstetric Induction
- 100% remain in hospital



Normal risk Postdates

- Midwifery induction
- 62% remain in hospital



Normal risk Postdates

- Midwifery Induction
- 38% Outpatient



Nursing and Midwifery Celebrating Success in Dublin North Care Services.



- Nationally this is a new choice for normal risk women in Ireland
- Waiting times for normal risk postdates inductions have been reduced by over 85%
- 95% of midwifery inductions are within the first hour compared with 39% of obstetric inductions.
- Median time waiting; Midwifery inductions 12mins.
- Median waiting time for Obstetric inductions 1hr 24mins.
- 38% of Midwifery Inductions are returning home.
